

SPECIFICATIONS

Forcible Entry Tool System

Introduction

These purchase specifications cover the minimum requirements for a Forcible Entry Tool System to be purchased by _____. This system will consist of _____ individually sized Kelly Tools. This equipment is to be used by emergency service personnel in a wedge and sledge combination with a flat head axe.

Instructions to Bidders

Bidders shall conform as much as possible to these specifications. Exceptions or omissions must be set out in writing on a separate sheet entitled "Exceptions" which must accompany the bid. Failure to do so will result in an automatic rejection of the bid.

The buyer shall be the sole interpreter of the intent of any clause of these specifications and shall be the sole judge as to whether the equipment or any part thereof complies with the specifications.

The buyer reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive informalities in bidding, to negotiate small options with the successful bidder and to accept the bid, which in the opinion of the buyer, will be in its best interests.

Dimensions and Capacities

The Kelly Tool will be available in three sizes and adhere to the following lengths and weight:

Kelly Tool

The Kelly Tool shall be drop forged from high alloy steel on both Adz end and Claw. The Adz and Claw will be machine sharpened for easy access to a prying point. Both ends will be press fitted for easy access to a 1 in. (2.5 cm.) stress proof steel bar with machine grooved hand grips. The Adz end extends into a protruding Hammer Head to be used as a Striking tool or receive Hammer blows. The Claw will have a recessed nail puller and be parallel slotted to slip over locks, hasps and many gas shutoffs.

Warranty

The seller shall be required to furnish a warranty on the complete Forcible Entry Tool System as described in these specifications for the service intended of the buyer. All equipment furnished by the successful bidder shall be given a lifetime warranty against all defects in material and workmanship from the date of acceptance. The seller agrees to replace, without charge, any parts shown to be defective under the terms of this warranty.

Use, Care and Maintenance Manual

Seller shall provide an illustrated step-by-step guide on the use, care and maintenance of the Forcible Entry Tool System provided.
