

SPECIFICATIONS

Forcible Entry Tool System

Introduction

These purchase specifications cover the minimum requirements for a Forcible Entry Tool System to be purchased by _____. This system will consist of _____ individually sized Hooks and Chains. This equipment is to be used by emergency service personnel for the purpose of pulling, stabilizing and working with hydraulic rescue tools.

Instructions to Bidders

Bidders shall conform as much as possible to these specifications. Exceptions or omissions must be set out in writing on a separate sheet entitled "Exceptions" which must accompany the bid. Failure to do so will result in an automatic rejection of the bid.

The buyer shall be the sole interpreter of the intent of any clause of these specifications and shall be the sole judge as to whether the equipment or any part thereof complies with the specifications.

The buyer reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive informalities in bidding, to negotiate small options with the successful bidder and to accept the bid, which in the opinion of the buyer, will be in its best interests.

Dimensions and Capacities

The Chain shall have a working load capacity of 5,400 lb. (2,450 kg.) with a four to one safety factor. The Hook will be 6.5 in. (16 cm.) wide and 3/8 in. (1 cm.) long. The Hook and Chain shall come in three different sizes and weights:

Hook and Chain

The Forcible Entry Tool System shall include a large forged alloy steel Hook attached to a high test alloy steel Chain and Grab Hook. The Hook shall be chrome plated.

Warranty

The seller shall be required to furnish a warranty on the complete Forcible Entry Tool System as described in these specifications for the service intended of the buyer. All equipment furnished by the successful bidder shall be given a lifetime warranty against all defects in material and workmanship from the date of acceptance. The seller agrees to replace, without charge, any parts shown to be defective under the terms of this warranty.

Use, Care and Maintenance Manual

Seller shall provide an illustrated step-by-step guide on the use, care and maintenance of the Forcible Entry Tool System provided.
